#### Hinduism

Key Belief – Dharma. (Right-living, respecting life, honouring Natural world) Deity (Brahman, Deva, Devi, Avatar)

#### Christianity

"God is love" (1 John 4.8) – compassionate, all knowing (omniscient), everywhere at once (omnipresent), all powerful (almighty) Humans as 'the stewards of creation'.

#### Islam

Key belief – Islam (Submission to the will of Allah)

'Straight Path' or the Shariah Qur'an is the original and most basic source of God's Law

Humans have the role of Khalifah, trustees of Allah's creation.
