
1. I think RSHE is an important part of the school curriculum?

Individual comments:

"I really don't like the boxing of a set of widely held and more widely aspired to values as 'British'. This implies a non-existent exceptionalism."

"I think children should be made aware of the danger of "LGBT free zones."

Individual comments:

"There a + after LGBTQ which is more inclusive than without, it involves everyone in the LGBTQ+ community."
