Thank you very much to those parents who responded to the online questionnaire. We really appreciate the additional time some people have spent to voice their opinions and messages of praise and thanks. As a result, we have analysed the information and we are already working on the areas for improvement. During next year, we will be sharing with you, through our Newsletters, Twitter, Class Dojo, our action points to address the issues some parents raised.

In total 44% (138 out of 315 children) of our parents returned their questionnaires - thank you

Results for each statement. Percentages do not always total 100% because of rounding. These results are from the **132 returned questionnaires, only.**

KEY AREAS OF SUCCESS

- My child enjoys coming to school

We were delighted that **94%** of you stated that you feel your child enjoys coming to school. This has been a challenging time for everyone and it is so rewarding to see a very high percentage of parents and children continue to enjoy coming to school.

96% of you stated that your child feels safe at school and again this is something which we are extremely pleased with.

- Members of staff are accessible and approachable

96% of you stated that you felt you we are accessible and approachable. We are extremely proud of this result.

- The school communicates with me effectively

92% either strongly agreed or agreed. However, we still need to improve regular and advanced communication with you to keep you updated on how they are doing in class. We encourage all staff to use Class Dojo as a way of keeping you informed as things actually happen in class and look for different ways to keep you informed about their progress across the curriculum as only **38%** strongly agree that you are well informed about their child's progress and achievement.

I would also like to thank you for your responses to how the school is led and managed and especially that you would recommend St Paul's School to another family indicating **96% Strongly Agree / Agreeing**. All the staff are very proud of our school and thank you for your amazing support!


AREAS OF DEVELOPMENT
