### ✓ EMPHASISE THE FOLLOWING TO CHILDREN AND STAFF – GIVING REMINDERS

- If no tissue is available, they should cough or sneeze in their elbow or sleeve
- Avoid touching your mouth, nose or eyes with unwashed hands
- Where possible, avoid people who are unwell

## WHAT WE ASK OF YOU:

- ✓ We ask that visitors make sure they wash their hands regularly and follow the guidance above.
- ✓ We ask that you let us know if any of your staff members attending the site or anyone from your own client base have confirmed to you any recent travel they may have undertaken to category 1 or 2 countries.
- ✓ We ask that you let us know if any of your staff members attending the site or anyone from your own client base have confirmed to you that they are unwell with coronavirus symptoms or confirmed coronavirus.

Please be rest assured that the school leadership are monitoring the situation closely. We are following expert advice from Public Health England and we will endeavour to ensure, as far as practicable, that an appropriate common sense approach will be taken when mitigating actions are taken to manage the risk to the wider community.
